Ingredient Assessment in the 21st Century: Reaffirming the Role of Marine Ingredients

Dr Brett Glencross

Many of the roles taken by Dr Brett Glencross over the past 25 years have had a focus on ingredient assessment and it has helped shape his thoughts on the scientific evaluation strategies used for assessing ingredients. This presentation re-examines what strategies worked, what didn't and why the sequence of ingredient assessment is critically important. In this reflection, Dr Glencross will also expand on where he thinks the science of ingredient assessment is heading and how marine ingredients are clearly reaffirming their role as strategic ingredients in modern aquaculture nutrition.

Currently, he is the Technical Director of IFFO (The Marine Ingredients Organisation) having commenced this role in June 2021. Prior to this role he was the Professor of Nutrition at the Institute of Aquaculture at the University of Stirling in Scotland, where he maintains an honorary position. Over the past 25 years he has worked in various academic, institutional, and industrial roles across Asia, Oceania, the Middle East and Europe. His career has been characterized by a close working relationship with many aquaculture production (farming) and feed companies throughout each of these regions. His research achievements have delivered many industrial outcomes resulting in the development of new processes, products, and applications. For his achievements in this regard, Brett has received multiple awards and commendations from both Government and Industrial organisations. He was the convening chair of the Feeds and Feeding thematic review at the recent FAO Global Conference on Aquaculture held in Shanghai. Brett has Honours and Masters Degrees in Biochemistry from the University of Western Australia and a PhD in Animal Nutrition from the University of Queensland.
